

JOB DESCRIPTION - COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING

Minimum requirements:

- Interest in working with children.
- Interest in Camp Gregory.
- Potential to be a camp counselor.
- Potential for leadership.
- Willingness to learn.
- At least 15 years old.
- Be familiar with Camp Gregory history, philosophy and facilities.
- Adhere to the staff guidelines.

Responsible to:

Counselors in charge of the cabin assigned; directors.

General Responsibility:

This is a volunteer opportunity to learn first-hand about working with young children and to prepare to be a camp counselor; this position offers a transition from camper to counselor.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Attend staff training.
- Assist counselors in charge of the cabin assigned.
- Assist the cabin group in camp housekeeping duties.
- Assist with small group activities.
- Participate responsibly in camp-wide activities.
- Follow the Camping Program Committee and Director's guidelines.
- Show respect for the campers, other staff, and yourself.
- Behave as a member of the staff, not as a camper.
- Ask questions when unclear about expectations or duties.
- Be open to feedback from other staff members and supervisors.
